
ABOUT THE ATTORNEY BUILD

The Habitat for Humanity of Greater Sacramento Annual Attorney Build brings together various law firms and various businesses to help build hope and homes for families in need.

Participating firms donate both the funds needed to build the home for a hardworking low-income family in our community, as well as the muscle through volunteer "buildable hours".

Attorney Build partners are encouraged to join us on the jobsite with any combination of lawyers, interns, summer clerks, and/or staff as we come together to build camaraderie, community, and homes.

Habitat for Humanity of Greater Sacramento is now actively recruiting for our 2017 Attorney Build which will take place in summer of 2017 on our 43rd Avenue project in South Sacramento.







ABOUT THE AVENUES PROJECT

The Avenues Project will be a 5-home Habitat development in South Sacramento. It will be our second largest multi-unit development in Habitat Greater Sacramento's 30 year history and will be located between Martin Luther King Blvd and 43rd Ave.

The land is currently vacant and was provided, along with the underground infrastructure for the entire project, through a partnership with the Sacramento Housing Redevelopment Agency (SHRA).

All 5 homes will be built to the highest level of LEED building standards to provide added sustainability for the future Habitat homeowners. The entire project will take roughly two years from the start of above ground construction and require \$750,000 in in-kind and financial sponsorships.

We are currently working to raise the remaining sponsorship dollars to fully cover the cost of construction for the first home of the 5 home project.





ABOUT THE HOMES

The homes in the Avenues will be 4-bedroom, 2 –bath, 2-story homes that will be built to LEED Platinum Standards to provide added sustainability for the low-income families who will eventually live there.

In addition to other LEED features, the homes will include drought tolerant landscaping, solar panels, and will have ratings that are 20-25% higher than current California Title 24 standards require.

Each partner family will put in 500 hours of sweat equity alongside volunteers and then purchase the home through a 0% interest, 30-year mortgage.

The avenues project will begin in the late summer of 2017 and take a little under 2 years to complete.





ABOUT THE FAMILIES



4 of the 5 future families of "The Avenues Project" have still to be officially assigned as families must first hit 100 hours of sweat equity before receiving their home assignment, however the first family of The Avenues Project, will be the Wube family, a family of 4 supported by single mother Elisabeth Wube. Elisabeth currently works several jobs and takes care of her two young children and elderly mother. They have been living in an overcrowded apartment for as long as the children have been alive and have longed to one day have the opportunity to own their own home.

Elisabeth, like all Habitat partner families and her future neighbors in The Avenues project, is a local, low-income family of 4-8 that is making an income (possibly working 2-3 minimum wage jobs to make ends meet), but not able to afford a home through conventional means.

Habitat families will have qualified for the home based on need such as:

- Substandard conditions (mold, rodent infestation, electrical issues, etc.)
- Over-crowded (such as a family of four living in a one-bedroom apartment).

The families will also have to be willing partner with us and work for their dream of homeownership by putting in 500 hours building their future home and the future homes of their neighbors. They will also pay the full cost of their home through a 30-year, 0% interest mortgage.


