About Rock the Block Oak Park 2026

Rock the Block is a two-day Habitat community impact event that brings together hundreds of volunteers to work in partnership with residents to invest in and revitalize Oak Park neighborhoods.

Over the past seven years, with ongoing support from the City of Sacramento, SMUD, Sacramento Impact Partners and the Sacramento Promise Zone Financial Institution Collaborative, as well as numerous corporate partnerships, Habitat's Rock the Block efforts in Oak Park have preserved critically needed affordable housing by repairing over 105 homes for low-income families, seniors and Veterans. This annual event has also revitalized this historically neglected neighborhood through numerous community enhancement projects at area schools, churches and communal gardens.

Volunteer activities during Rock the Block Oak Park include a variety of home repairs, as well as neighborhood enhancement projects that can include painting, fence repairs and community landscaping/clean-up.
