The City of Elk Grove also operates a Special Waste Collection Center for residents and businesses that accepts HHW, tires, sharps, and unused medications. A Reuse Room is onsite for household items including paint, cleaners, pool supplies, and clean wood. This facility also accepts recyclables.

***Please note that the Sacramento County's HHW program is also open to residents of Elk Grove, Folsom, Galt, and Rancho Cordova. The City of Citrus Heights does not participate in the County HHW program. Citrus Heights residents may not bring materials to either the County's NARS facility or the County's Kiefer ABOP facility. Businesses may also bring hazardous waste materials to NARS or SRTS. Fees are charged depending on material type.
