Women Build is an annual project that recruits and empowers women of all different ages, backgrounds, and industries to come together to build homes and make a powerful and visible impact on our local community through housing.

Over the month of May, 20 teams of women will work together through Women Build to raise funds and build homes with Habitat for Humanity of Greater Sacramento. Commencing on May 1st with a special Women Build kick-off rally followed by a month-long build, Women Build is a truly unique and exciting opportunity for women in our community to come together, no matter what their skill levels, and roll up their sleeves to promote positive, women-led impact.

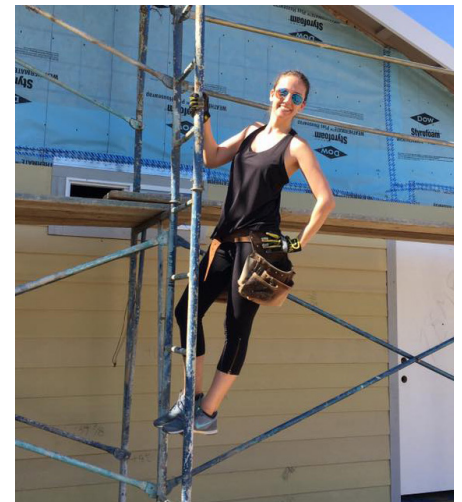
